

Guidelines for Video Submission

General Overview

The presentation of videos is part of the activities. It will offer the authors the opportunity to share their experiences, projects, research, and scientific advances with the participants of the event.

The videos should not advertise products or services. For this purpose, the event will offer spaces for exhibitions and networking.

The purpose of the video should be to promote and improve health care by applying the principles of Robotic Surgery.

Video Submission Criteria

All videos must be submitted according to the following structure:

- The authors' identification should be provided in the body of the email, with first name, last name, and affiliation of each author;
- The file must be named after the title of the video;
- Areas: videos featuring projects in the areas of health, education, welfare, and social will be accepted;

Criteria for production and acceptance of videos

Only videos that meet the requirements described below will be accepted:

- Submission through the event's email: congressotoracica@einstein.br
- The final file will be used for presentation at the event and must be submitted by **June 3, 2022;**
- Quality and scientific, educational, and/or social content;
- Meet the ethical and legal aspects of the profession;
- Each author is responsible for the production of the video, according to the following format:
 - ✓ **File type: MP4 (h.264) or AVI**
 - ✓ **Maximum length of time: 5 - 7 minutes**
 - ✓ **Size must not exceed 100mb**
- The video must contain in its credits the following information: title of the work, name, surname, and affiliation of each author;
- Make an attractive, creative video that captures attention and clearly communicates the main points of your work.

Presentation of the videos approved

- The person responsible for the submission will receive an e-mail informing the status of submission and acceptance of your video.
- After the work has been accepted, no editing of any information will be allowed, including the removal/inclusion of authors;
- The presentation of the 16 best videos will take place: 8 presentations on June 16, 2022 from 1:30-3:30pm and 8 presentations on June 17, 2022 from 4-6pm during the Congress.
